## What areas are you interested in helping with during the campaign?

### **BOOTH CAPTAIN**

Set up ALP stand outside polling booth prior to 8am on Election day, to get the best spot and pack up at 6pm. In the week prior to polling day, contact volunteers allocated to the booth to reconfirm their election day shift.

### **Letterboxing/leaflets**

Be allocated a patch of streets, dropping an election brochure or direct mail (addressed) letter into each letterbox before the election.

### **Transport**

On election day transport people who cannot make their own way to the polling booth. You may also need to help them fill in the ballot, with the permission of AEC staff.

### **Provide a poster site at your home or business**

### **Hand out how to vote cards**

Be assigned to a polling booth for as long as you can spare on election day. Blocks are in 2 hour lots beginning at 8am and ending at 6pm.

### **Phone calling**

Before the election phone volunteers to allocate times, letterboxing areas and polling booth duties.

### **Postal Voters**

Visit postal voters (usually elderly or disabled) who require help completing their ballot paper. This usually occurs before election day.

### **Door knocking**

Be allocated a patch of streets, doorknocking each home before the election. You will work with at least one other person for safety, possibly Duncan. You will be given pamphlets, advice on how to approach people and what to say.

### **Mobile polling**

Work with the AEC visiting mobile polling booths such as hospitals and nursing homes. This usually occurs in the weeks prior to the election.

### **Posters**

Work in a team before the election driving to homes and businesses to put up election posters. And/or after the election, help remove the same posters.
